Joan Eileen Oskamp, born November 6, 1933, in Oceanside, Long Island New York, daughter of George and Millie Steutel, passed away February 26, 2016 in Palm Beach Gardens, Florida. She lived in New York and in North Caldwell, New Jersey and graduated Bloomfield High School and William Paterson

College in New Jersey with a degree in early childhood education. Joan met and married her husband of 58 years, Dr. Edwin Oskamp in 1957. She taught elementary school for 25 years in New Jersey prior to retiring and moving to Florida. She loved her job with first graders, as children and young people were one of her life's loves. Joan helped to create community wherever she went, which could be seen in her caring relationships, her work with the Social Committee

Governor's Point Condominiums, and her extensive work with the Rotary International Youth Exchange Program, which included hosting at least a dozen foreign students in her home over the years. A member of Trinity United Methodist Church in Palm Beach Gardens, Joan spent much of her time keeping in touch with her children and grandchildren and with her bridge club women, enjoying friendship and life. She was a lifelong member of the National Education Association and the New Jersey Education Association. She was awarded a Paul Harris Fellowship by the Rotary Club of Hampton Township, NJ. Joan leaves her husband, Dr. Edwin Oskamp, two daughters, Reverend Shirley Oskamp of Middletown Springs, Vermont, and Suellyn McGlew of Stillwater, New Jersey. Four grandchildren include Sarah Colletti, Caitlin Colletti, Kylie McGlew, and Lauren McGlew, and her only brother George Steutel and his wife Gene of Palm Harbor, Florida. Also, a brother-in-law Richard Oskamp with his wife June of Sussex, New Jersey.
