Pauline Florence (Flo) Dinzik (Deutschlander) died peacefully on April 9, 2018 in Tequesta, Florida, just short of her 91st birthday..

She gave freely to others, both materially and of her time and energy. She also was a crusader for her Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ, and never failed to share the Gospel with the people that came into her life. Much of life is about maintaining a balance, and Flo managed to make life fun for those around her while keeping her focus on eternity. She even insisted on naming the family boat "Fun Time"! Her grandchildren all recall the many happy times spent with their grandmother, whether racing around in a golf cart, or filling a shopping cart at the local mall. Whatever the activity, they recall the fun that they had with her. Her friends will recall many happy hours around a bridge table, where nothing made Flo happier than to have a great hand of cards!
