Bud, as he was affectionately known, was raised in Ponte Vedra Beach, FL. He was a graduate of the Hackley School in Tarrytown, NY and attended Amherst college in Amherst, MA. After graduation he served as a First Lieutenant and Single Engine Jet Pilot/Instructor in the United States Air Force in Laredo, TX. He started his sales career with IBM in Jacksonville, FL in 1959. Two years later IBM moved him to Miami, FL. In 1964 he started his financial consulting career, which was to span over 50 years, with Connecticut General Life Insurance Company as a specialist in business and estate planning. CG merged with INA in 1982 and became CIGNA. In 1999 his division was sold to the Lincoln Financial Group where Bud worked until his retirement in 2017. He was a dedicated golfer, a member of the the Society of Seniors and a member and good friend of the Abaco Golf Club in Jupiter, FL. A reminder from his father to “always try to make a difference in the lives of others” which he always tried to do. He will be remembered and missed. Rest in Peace.

Bud is survived by his beloved wife, Anne, of 44 years and a son, Walker in Jacksonville, FL.
