Capt. Alfons Carl Marczyński USN Ret., 70 of Palm Beach Gardens, passed away on May 29th 2014. He was a true patriot, a devoted husband, and loving parent.

Al was born in Germany on May 5th 1944. At the age of 13, he immigrated to Boston with his family from Poland. He graduated from the University of Maine and received his Masters from the Naval Post Graduate School. Al proudly served in the Navy for 30 years as a submariner and held many commands within the Supply Corp. He received the Legion of Merit award and retired from the Navy in 1998. Al enjoyed golfing, biking, and spending time with family.
