



## Alice Vail Quinn

January 7, 1952 - January 18, 2025

Alice Vail Quinn, 73, of Newtown Square, PA, and Jupiter, FL, died peacefully surrounded by her loving family on Saturday, January 18, 2025, at Jupiter Medical Center.

Alice was born in 1952 to parents Charles and Pat Vail, the fourth of eight children. Alice grew up in Lansdowne, PA, and graduated from Archbishop Prendergast High School. Alice went on to earn a Bachelor's degree in Philosophy from Cabrini College and continued her education at the University of Dayton, where she taught and obtained a Master's degree in Philosophy.
