Alice Carolyn (Carol) Volpe, 83, of Jupiter, Florida (formerly of Houston, Pennsylvania), was graciously received into the arms of the Lord Jesus Christ, surrounded by family, on April 13, 2019 in Jupiter. Carol was born Christmas Eve, 1935, in Bedford, Pennsylvania, a daughter of Robert & Alice Foy. On August 19, 1956 she married her college sweetheart, Ralph R. Volpe, who survives. Carol and Ralph served the Lord together for more than 62 years.
