Ann Lynn (Darby) Nunley, age 89, of Jupiter, Florida, passed away peacefully on Tuesday, October 27, in the comfort of her home surrounded by family.

Ann was born on August 11, 1936, to D. Lynn and Edith C. Darby. She married Charles E. Nunley in 1956, and together they shared 67 wonderful years before his passing in October 2023.

A devoted mother of two and grandmother of four, Ann will be remembered for her deep love of family and steadfast devotion to her faith and church.
