



## Dr. Anthony Gerardi

September 28, 1933 - December 14, 2024

Dr. Anthony Gerardi, beloved husband, father, grandfather, brother, uncle, and friend, passed away peacefully while surrounded by his wife and children on December 14, 2024 in Jupiter, FL. He was 91.

Born in the Bronx, NY on September 28, 1933, he was the son of the late Biagio and Frances Gerardi and brother to beloved sister, Amalia, who predeceased him. Anthony spent much of his life in the New York metropolitan area, growing up in the Bronx and Brooklyn; graduating from New York University (Phi Beta Kappa) and SUNY Downstate Medical Center (Alpha Omega Alpha); completing his medical training in Allergy and Internal Medicine at Roosevelt Hospital; meeting the love of his life in Miami Beach, FL and marrying in New York City, NY; opening his private medical practice in Yonkers, NY; raising his family of five children in Scarsdale, NY; later residing in the Hudson Valley (Dobbs Ferry, NY) before permanently relocating to Palm Beach Gardens, FL.

Anthony is survived by his wife of 64 years, Carolyn Ann (nee Rondinelli) of Palm Beach Gardens, FL; his daughter, Diane Gerardi and her fiancé, Maarten Moog, of New York City, NY and Palm Beach Gardens, FL; his daughter, Linda Revelli and her husband John of Westport, CT, along with their three children, Stephen (wife Jen), Christina, and Charlotte; his daughter, Dr. Cynthia Gerardi and her husband William Gahan of Juno Beach, FL, along

with their three children, Owen, Reed, and Elena; his son, Michael, wife Kara, and their three children, Jackson, Emme, and Jamie, of Palm Beach Gardens, FL; and his daughter, Melissa, and her two sons, Sarkis and Anthony, of Los Angeles, CA. He was adored by his eleven grandchildren, to whom he was simply "Pa Tony" and/or "PopPop." He will be greatly missed by his nieces, nephews, dear friends (including his close-knit circle at Ballenisesles Country Club), as well as his team of devoted physicians who deeply respected him as a colleague.

Anthony's legacy of wisdom, strength, strong Catholic faith, pride for his Italian heritage, and devotion to family will continue to inspire all who knew him. He will be dearly missed and fondly remembered by all of whom had the privilege of knowing him.
