Anton Schweighardt (Tony), 92 passed away on April 15, 2026 in Jupiter, Florida.

Tony was born in Gant, Hungary and lived there until 1946. After WWII the family of 5 were removed by the Hungarian communists because of their German descent. They were sent to Germany and worked on a farm for room and board. In 1952, Tony's parents Simon and Anna Schweighardt (predeceased) decided they wanted a better life for their 3 boys and left for America. No one spoke English but Ma, Pa, brother Andrew (predeceased), and Tony secured jobs quickly. Tony started his career as a machinist for a tool and die shop.

Tony, signed up for the US Army becoming a Corporal and water purifier specialist serving his new country honorably. He loved the USA only buying American cars, Cadillacs when he was able to afford them.

Tony was a very hard-working man and wanted the American dream so he opened up his own business in the basement of his NJ home. Eventually he had his own machine shop employing many workers from Europe. He was also an entrepreneur owning car washes and a strip mall with his younger brother, Simon.

Tony met his beloved wife, Katherine Stadler (predeceased) at a dance hall and they were married for 60 years settling in Little Falls and Totowa with their 3 children; Anna Marie Babucke (Fred), Thomas Schweighardt (Maria), and Janet Hoek (Steven). He was a loving grandfather to Kristen Marshall (David), Katelyn Lepselter (Maxx), Thomas Schweighardt, Jesse Faulkner (Rick), Samantha Murphy (Brian), Leah Hoek and Daniel Hoek (Megan Seoane).
