Dr. Benjamin T. Bernstein born on April 4, 1934 of Brooklyn descent passed away on March 9, 2016. He is survived by his beloved wife of 59 years, Claire, two children Louis Bernstein and Liz (Keith)Braude, four grandchildren Felicia, Sarah, Ariel and Aaron, and sister Shirley. A self-made man with accomplishments, including a Ph.D in Physical Chemistry and Physics, project manager for the Project Mercury space program, holder of over twenty US and foreign patents, including the first microchip computer controlled cycling machine, author of numerous articles in scientific journals, fellow and member of various scientific organizations, President and CEO of Eisenberg USA, Inc., an international development company involved in transactions around the world valued at hundreds of millions of dollars, he was at the forefront in developing relations between China and the United States in the 1970s and an author of a book of non-fiction of his Eisenberg years. His passions extended to his love of art, literature, music and the old-fashioned art of storytelling. He learned much but taught more to those who encountered him, in particular to his family, who will miss him, not just for his lessons but as a man, husband, father and grandfather.
