NOBLE, Benjamin Nicholas Age 84 formerly of Hackensack, New Jersey passed away on December 21st, 2013 after a brief illness. He was the son of the late Benjamin (Sr.) and Rose Noble. Ben was married to the late Grace Sortino Noble for 58 years. They were Jupiter residents for many years. Ben was a Business Owner most of his life beginning with his father in New Jersey selling and servicing televisions, appliances, pianos and organs and after moving to Florida he owned several electronics stores. Before retiring Ben was the proprietor of Noble's Texaco on Indiantown Road and S. Loxahatchee Drive in Jupiter. Ben was a member of the U.S. Army Signal Corps during the Korean Conflict from March of 1951 until February of 1953. He was stationed in Germany and was responsible for maintaining and repairing radar equipment. He was Honorably Discharged holding the rank of Corporal and awarded the Army of Occupation Medal (Germany). Ben is survived by his sons Glenn, Curtis, and Ryan and his daughter Carrie, Grandchildren Anthony, Jill, Riley, Spencer and Ben, and Great Grandchildren Angelina, and Mia. Services will be at Taylor & Modeen Funeral Home, 250 Center St., Jupiter on Friday, December 27th, 2013. Viewing will be from 2 to 4 PM and 6 to 8 PM. Funeral Mass will be at 10 AM on Saturday, December 28th, 2013 at St. Peter Catholic Church, 1701 Indian Creek Parkway, Jupiter with entombment to follow at Riverside Memorial Park in Tequesta.
