Bernard D. (Bernie) Larose, 83, of Palm Beach Gardens, FL passed away peacefully on September 16, 2023, at Trustbridge Hospice of Jupiter, surrounded by his loving family.

Bernie was born in Springfield, Massachusetts, to Daniel A. and Laretta (Labossiere) Larose, where he grew up with his sister, Gloria. Through much hard work and perseverance, Bernie achieved great professional success and through his unwavering love and commitment to his
