



Beverly Wyly Dunn

June 13, 1942 - June 6, 2021

Beverly “Bevo” Wyly Dunn, DDS, of West Palm Beach, FL. passed away on June 6, 2021 surrounded by family and love. He was born in Portsmouth, NH on June 13, 1942. He graduated from Gonzaga High School in Washington, DC and went on to obtain a BS from Mount St. Mary’s College, a DDS from University of Maryland, a Residency in Implant Surgery at Misch Institute for Advanced Implant Surgery and joined the US Army Reserve Dental Corps, rising to the level of Captain. Bevo established a private practice as a dentist and implant surgeon in Bethesda, MD. He married the love of his life, Alana Elaine Dunn in 1987.

He was a member of the American Dental Association, The Maryland State Dental Association, Academy of General Dentistry and American Academy of Implant Dentistry. He had many accomplishments over the course of his career including: Fellow, The Misch Implant Institute 1993; Diplomat, International Congress Oral Implantologists, 1994; Fellow, American Academy of Implant Dentistry, 1997; Fellow, The Academy of General Dentistry, 1997; American Academy of Implant Dentistry Admission and Credentials Board Chairman, 2004 and President, American Academy of Implant dentistry, 2009. He was awarded The Washingtonian Magazine- Best Dentists in Washington, D.C. and the National Consumers Health Council, The Best Dentists in America.

Bevo was a devoted parishioner at the Cathedral of St. Ignatius Loyola and volunteered at their Food Pantry. He loved Bible Study and the strengthening of his faith. He was past board member of Ibis Charities and Villagio Homeowners Association. In his leisure time Bevo enjoyed photography and the Ibis Photography Club. He was an avid golfer and enjoyed all University of Maryland sports, especially basketball. He touched the lives of many and will be deeply missed by his family, colleagues, friends.

He is survived by his wife, Alana Dunn; his children Tim Dunn and wife Hillary, Kevin Dunn and wife Megan, Brian Dunn and wife Lina and Julie Carroll and husband Jonathan; sister, Molly Bigelow; brothers Bobby (Kathy) and Mark Dunn; brothers in law Jim and Fred (Barbara) Barnette; 11 grandchildren; one great grandchild; one God son; and many

nieces, nephews, friends and his beloved dog Rascal. He was predeceased by his parents, Beverly W. Dunn, II and Margaret M. O'Connor Dunn and brother Jimmy Dunn.
