Brian Michael Bradley, beloved husband, father, uncle, brother and dedicated grandfather, age 62, died October 16th, 2022 in Jupiter, Florida after being stricken ill unexpectedly.

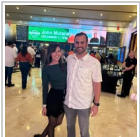
