Charles “Chuck” was born in Brooklyn, NY in 1940. He was the first born son of Raymond and Fay Caruana. He is survived by his son James Paul Caruana, wife Jennifer and their family; His daughter Denise Caruana Trageser, husband Joseph and their family; and his sister Carolyn Carlson. Chuck had been fighting cancer for a number of years and went home to the Lord on January 5, 2023.

Chuck received a BA degree from Brooklyn College in 1962 and entered Naval officer candidate school upon graduation. He served 5 years as a Naval Officer, including 2 years for Vietnam. Upon release from active duty, Chuck entered the financial business and returned to NYCC Graduate School of Business Administration in New York.

He ultimately moved to Boca Raton, FL in 1972 where he raised his family. Through the years, Chuck was a member of Spanish River Community Church and Boca Raton Community Church. Before he retired, he worked at Keating Investments Counselors in Delray Beach. Chuck then moved to Juno Beach in 2012 and resided at the Waterford and attended Christ Fellowship Church in Palm Beach Gardens.

Chuck was a conservative Republican with an intense love for God, his country, his family and the Miami Dolphins. He will be dearly missed by his

family and his close friends.
