Christine N. McDonald (nee New), age 102, widow of Richard William McDonald, of Plantation, FL, passed away on Friday, November 19, 2010, at her residence. She was born in Hoboken, NJ, to the late John and Christine New. Mrs. McDonald lived in New Milford and Beach Haven, NJ, for many years before moving to Florida. She retired from the NJ Bell Telephone Company where she served as Chief Operator of the Hackensack Toll Office.
