She is survived by her husband of 40 years, Harry Lodes who resides in Jupiter Florida. Her sisters Nel, Wil, Fransien, Gon, Anneka, and Cobie who live in Holland and brother Bram who lives in Deerfield will remember Corry as fun, energetic and with a great sense of humor. Her memory lives on through her two children Bram Lodes 28 and Katie Lodes 22 who describe their mother as a ray of sunshine. She was predeceased by her parents Frans and Petronella Krijger.
