Dorothy “Dottie” (Falvey) Van Keuren, 88, beloved wife, mother, grandmother, sister and friend passed away peacefully on October 19, 2022, in Jupiter, Florida.

Born on March 21, 1934, the oldest of 12 children of Edmund and Nellie Falvey of Worcester, Massachusetts, Dottie graduated from Ascension High School in Worcester, and was a secretary for Paul Revere Insurance Company. In 1959, she married William C. “Bill” Van Keuren and the couple relocated to Vernon, Connecticut where they began raising their family of six children. In 1976 the family relocated to Tequesta, Florida where she lived the rest of her life.

Dottie is predeceased by her devoted and loving husband, Bill. The two visited many countries after his retirement in 1993, and through their travels she was able to visit the homeland of her ancestors to kiss the Blarney Stone. 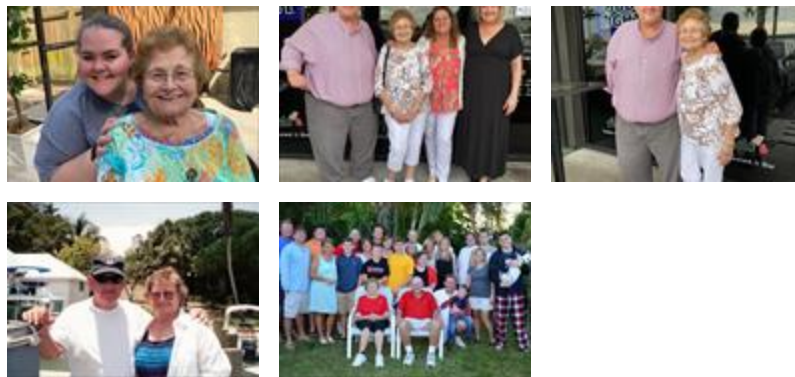
