Douglas R. Dunham, USAF Master Sergeant (Retired), 71, passed away at his home in Jupiter, Florida on Tuesday, February 17, 2015. Doug was born October 9, 1943 in Portland, Connecticut to the late Alice and Lewis Dunham. In 1961, Doug was sworn into the United States Air Force where he proudly and honorably served for twenty-six years with deployments to Korea, Vietnam and Germany. He then settled in his home state of Connecticut and opened the D & W (Doug and Wife) Service Station in East Hampton. One day in 1986, tired of the snow, he came home and said "Let's move to Florida". "Okay" said his wife, Betty. They moved to Jupiter where he resided for the last 29 years, and opened Absolute Signs & Service in 1991, successful for over 20 years. Doug was an active member of the Loyal Order of Moose, Fraternal Order of Eagles Aerie 4267 in Jupiter, and the American Legion Post 271 in Tequesta. He loved fishing and playing poker.
