Frederick C. Weiss Jr., age 81, of Jupiter, passed away Tuesday, October 7, 2014. He was a retired Vice President and former manager for Merrill Lynch, a member of the Charles E. Merrill Circle, past chairman of the Business Development Board of Palm Beach County, and Board of Trustee member for the Center for Family Services of Palm Beach County. Frederick attended Nazareth Hall Military School in Toledo, Ohio; Georgia Military Academy in Atlanta, Georgia; and was a graduate of the U.S. Naval Academy Class of 1957.
