Fred A. Urban, 90, of Palm Beach Gardens, FL passed away peacefully on Sunday June 22nd.

Fred was born to parents Andrew and Antoinette Urban in 1934 and was raised as an only child in Norwalk, CT. He graduated from Western Connecticut State College and became an elementary school teacher. Fred would go on to earn a master's degree at Columbia University and became the youngest school principal in the Norwalk School System. Fred dedicated his 35-year career to education.
