George Ronald Sciarrino, age 64 of Jupiter, FL, died peacefully on Friday, February 24, 2012, among his family and friends. Born September 5, 1947, in Paterson, New Jersey, he also lived in the states of New York, California, and Florida. In 1971, he graduated from Seton Hall University with a B.S. in Social Studies and English. In 1974, he earned his J.D. from New England School of Law, where he was the President of the Student Bar Association.

George went on to work for the U.S. Department of Justice, Immigration and Naturalization Service. He then started his own immigration law practice, where he practiced law for the past thirty-five years in both New Jersey and Florida. His passions in life included landscaping, traveling, boating, garage sales and art.

Survivors include his beloved wife, Salwa Sciarrino; his son, George Christian Sciarrino; three brothers, Joseph, Gary and John; and his mother, Agnes Sciarrino.
