Gilbert Wayne Cartier of Juno Beach, FL and Manchester, CT, died on January 5, 2014 at the age of 84. Born on June 18, 1929 in Chicopee, MA to the late Romeo and Alice Cartier, Wayne was a loving father to his four children: Wayne "Sparky" Cartier, Karen Holmes, David Cartier and the late Stephen Cartier. Wayne was also a devoted husband of 36 years to Lorraine Cartier, adored grandfather to Jason Cartier, Julie Cartier, Michael "Ty" Cartier and Dylan Cartier, and Great Grandfather to Taylor Cartier, Ava Cartier and Evan Cartier.
