She also worked as an industrial nurse for RCA and then the Town of Palm Beach. Everywhere she went she made lifelong friends. For a time in the 1970s Grace also was employed by the Palm Beach County Health Department bringing her incredible compassion and care to her fellow citizens, young and old, in the City of Riviera Beach. Near the end of a long career Grace worked a time as a private duty nurse and then for the State of Florida's Children's Medical

Services where she provided care to profoundly ill children, and loving understanding to their parents and guardians. While all that would be enough to fill two lifetimes, Grace was also an amazing Mom, friend, entertainer, comedienne and poet; she championed the downtrodden and praised the Lord, we know she'll be the life of the party as she travels through Paradise.
