Harold Eugene Root, 79, passed away on May 14, 2024, at the Luxe Rehabilitation Center in Jupiter Florida. Harold was married to Mary Lou Root (Bernardi). Harold and Mary Lou resided in Palm Beach Gardens, Florida. Harold was born in Monticello, Illinois on September 28, 1944. His parents were Robert and Mary Jane Root, last of Palm Beach Gardens.

Harold's early years were spent in Decatur, Illinois where his father was an electrician for A.E. Staley company and his mother was a stay-at-home mom. Harold was an active athletic child, excelling at basketball. Harold made the Decatur High School basketball team as a sophomore. The Decatur High School Running Reds were a noted basketball power in central Illinois. This led Harold to a life-long love of all sports, particularly cheering on his favorite teams: Miami Heat, Marlins, and Dolphins.

Harold moved to Florida with his parents, 2 of his brothers and a sister in 1961 when Harold was 17. Harold enlisted in the Army in July of 1965 and was honorably discharged in July of 1967. Harold was in the Military Police unit at Fort Leonard Wood in Missouri.

Harold married the love of his life, Mary Lou Bernardi, on September 21, 1968. They had a long and loving marriage living their entire marriage in north Palm Beach County. 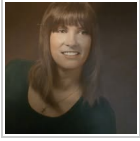

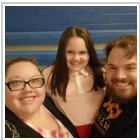
