Jack, W. Freital, 92, of Jupiter, Florida passed away Friday May 22nd at the Hospice of Palm Beach County facility in Jupiter, Florida.

Jack was born in Fairmount Indiana in 1923 to Lewis and Mildred Freital. In 1943 he enlisted in the U.S. Army and served in the South Pacific in the Army Engineers Corp. where he received 4 Bronze Stars. Upon his discharge in 1946 he became employed with Alloy Products of Marion Indiana as a sheet-metal fabricator in the Aerospace Industry. He worked there until transferred in 1958 to Pratt and Whitney Aircraft in West Palm Beach Florida where he continued his work as a aerospace sheet-metal fabricator, he remained there for 29 1/2 years retiring in 1989.

In 1947 he married Lorene Lawson also of Fairmount Indiana. His wife of 63 years predeceased him in 2010. He has two sons both residing in Jupiter Florida. Ricky L. Freital and his wife Debra and Randy L Freital.

Jack was a 68 year member of the Fairmount Lodge No. 635 of Free and

Accepted Masons & the Fairmount Order of the Eastern Star. He was raised to a 32nd degree Mason at the Valley of Lake Worth Scottish Rite in 1998 and also joined the Amara Shrine Temple the same year.

He was kind, quiet, gentle and unassuming. He was a true Mason. He loved his family and was loved by all. He will be missed.
