James R. Brainerd, age 84, died on June 17, 2012 at his home in Jupiter, Florida. His first wife, Margaret, and his second wife, Sally, sisters, Suzanne B, Volkman and Mary R. Ewing, predeceased him. Surviving him are his sons, James R. Brainerd, Jr. and Len Coyne, and his daughters Joanne (Jodi) Jones and Marcy Coyne, eight grandchildren, nine great grandchildren, a brother, and two sisters.
