Jane Myrl Bradbury Russell, born March 17, 1933 passed away peacefully in her home in Palm Beach Gardens, Florida on March 6, 2014. A 1951 graduate of East High School in Nashville, Tennessee Jane lived in Columbia, Missouri for almost 30 years, working for the University of Missouri during that time. She retired to Palm Beach Gardens full time in 1992. A member of Trinity United Methodist Church, Jane was very active in the Palm Beach Gardens community, and was involved in a variety of community and charitable activities and organizations. She was an avid tennis player and was captain of the Senior Women's Tennis Team at PGA Resort & Club that won the Florida State Championship. Jane is survived by her husband, Garth S.
