Jane Ellen Powers, 70, of Jupiter, FL passed away on January 31, 2023. Jane was born in Reading, Pennsylvania to Ernest Follweiler and Helen Leiby Follweiler on November 27, 1952. She graduated from Kutztown University with a Bachelor of Science in Mathematics and later went on to earn a Masters in Mathematics. She spent her early post grad years as a math teacher.
