Jesse Norbert Lowery age 86, of Tequesta, went home to be with his Lord and Savior on November 7, 2020. Dad was born on March 11, 1934 to Jesse R. and Annie Liz Lowery in Rochelle, Ga. Jesse Norbert grew up in Pineview Ga. and entered the U.S. Navy in 1952 where he served as a radio operator on several U.S. submarines. Norb married his beautiful wife Bea in 1955 and earned a Bachelor of Electrical Engineering degree at the University of South Carolina.
