John, Edward McCleary, born September 23, 1928 in Farmington, MA to Elmer & Edith (Olsen) McCleary, John is preceded in death by his older sister Janet (McCleary) Brightman and is survived by his younger brother David McCleary. John leaves behind his wife Joyce Stevens (Greenway) McCleary, their three sons, Mark (Robin) of Jupiter FL, Alan (Maureen) of St. Augustine FL, and Michael of Wake Forest NC, eight grandchildren and 1 great-grandchild.

After graduating from high school in 1947 from Palmer, MA and upon his 18th birthday, John enlisted in the Air Force. While stationed at McDill AFB, Tampa, FL, he served with the Military Police Corp, Strategic Air Command (SAC). Pursuing his love for electronics, he subsequently trained as a radio repair specialist and transferred to a Strategic Air Command, rapid deployment base in North Africa. Discharged from military service in 1954, he returned home to Monson, MA where he completed his education at Western New England College in 1963.

While working for Pratt & Whitney in Hartford CT, John was transferred to Palm Beach Gardens, FL in 1981 and lived in PBG for several years before moving to Jupiter. John belonged to the Masonic Lodge, "Day Spring Lodge" in Monson, MA, then after relocating to Florida, he joined the Masonic Lodge in Florida as well as becoming a member of the Shriners (Flying Fez's) in

PBG.

John retired from Pratt & Whitney in 1992. He occupied his time with his passion for flying. He was an accomplished pilot, earning his Instrument Flight and High Performance (retractable) ratings.

John passed away peacefully on March 29th, 2013 at 2:32pm with his wife by his side. All are going to miss him, his laughter and wit. There will be a visitation for family and friends the evening of Monday April 01, 2013 from 6 – 7 PM with a funeral service at 7:00 PM. A graveside service will take place on Tuesday April 02, 2013 at the South Florida National Cemetery in Lake Worth at 11:00 AM.
