JOSEPH C. DWYER Age 68, of Port St. Lucie, FL, passed away Friday afternoon, June 19, 2020. Born in Baltimore, MD, he grew up in Jupiter/Tequesta and graduated Jupiter High School class of 1969. Joe graduated from University of South Florida in Tampa in 1976 and settled back in Jupiter to work for Pratt & Whitney.
