



Katherine Constantakos

November 6, 1925 - September 1, 2023

Katherine Constantakos, age 97, beloved wife, mother, grandmother (14), and great-grandmother (7) passed away on September 1, 2023. She was born on November 6, 1925, in Cranston, Rhode Island to Pietro and Virginia Monopoli. Her husband, John Constantakos, predeceased her in 2008. Katherine is survived by her children, Scott Constantakos (and wife Jeanne), Kathy Heyman, Joyce Dorow, John Constantakos, Jr. (and life-long partner, Tricia Coates); David Constantakos (and wife Patricia); Daniel Constantakos (and wife Pam); Michael Constantakos (and wife Jamie); and her brothers, Victor Monopoli and Peter Monopoli, Jr.

Katherine was a strong, caring, and loving woman, who was devoted to her family and her Roman Catholic faith. Her husband, John Constantakos, was a career Navy Chief Petty Officer, which required dedication, love, and time for Katherine to move around the country with her children wherever John was stationed. After John's Navy retirement, the family moved to the rural Berkshire mountains on General Knox Road, Woronoco, Massachusetts where once again Katherine carried the responsibility of raising her 7 children while John worked nights in Connecticut at Pratt & Whitney. During the time in the Berkshires', Katherine took up art and became an accomplished artist. She took on many landscaping projects with 27 acres to manage and worked tirelessly until completed, sometimes late into the evening. Her mother and father, five sisters and brothers brought her much joy and support during her

time alone raising her children. Katherine and John relocated with family in 1971 to work and retired to Jupiter, Florida, and were lovingly married for 55 years, before John preceded her in death in November 2008.

Katherine's final services will be held on Saturday, September 9, 2023. A funeral mass will start at 1:00 PM at St. Jude's Catholic Church, US1, Tequesta, Florida; 2:00 PM will be the final blessing and interment at Riverside Memorial Cemetery Tequesta, Florida.
