



## Kenneth Paul Seybel, Sr.

November 4, 1953 - November 18, 2010

Age 57 of Jupiter, FL, passed away November 18, 2010 after a courageous battle with pancreatic cancer. Born in Bayshore, NY, he had been a resident of Jupiter since 1972, coming from Islip, NY.
