Kevin O'Neil, a beloved brother, husband, father, grandfather, and friend, passed away on March 2, 2025, after a long battle with cancer. He was born to Vincent D. and Lillian F. Kevin continued his education at Suffolk University in Boston, where he earned his bachelor's degree in business administration.

After returning to Cape Cod, Kevin took over a small family insurance company and quickly became a successful entrepreneur. As his business grew through acquisitions and mergers, Dowling & O'Neil grew across Cape Cod, Nantucket, and Martha's Vineyard. He became the managing partner which he made many friendships and colleagues along the way. In 2005, he sold his company and retired, having built a legacy in the insurance industry.

Throughout his career, Kevin's business success led him to take on important roles in the community. He served as Chairman of the Town of Barnstable Public Works Commission for 12 years, was on the Board of the Barnstable County Bank, and was the President of the Cape Cod Insurance Agents Association.
