May 18, 1943 - June 20, 2025

Lee Alan Kellogg, 82, of Jupiter, Florida, passed away on June 20, 2025.

Lee was born in Onaway, Michigan, to Harold and Virginia, in 1943. After he graduated from Waterford High School in Oakland County, Michigan, he completed one year of college and then went on to serve in the U.S. Army for three years and an additional three years in the Reserves.

Lee married Hazel in 1966 and together they had three children, Chris, Craig and Cara. In 1976, the family moved from Michigan to South Florida. Here, Lee served his community as a police officer, retiring from the Broward Sheriff's Office (BSO) as a Lieutenant in 2000 after 24 years of service.

As an officer, Lee became the first School Resource Officer at Deerfield Beach High School. In 1984, he won the Fraternal Order of Police's Officer of the Year Award. He also received the Police Officers Hall of Fame Lifesaving Award in 1996 and, three years later,

was named Police Officer of the Year.

Throughout the years, Lee was an avid fisherman. His other “children” - Wellcraft, Sea Pro, and Dusky - also brought him a great deal of joy on the ocean!

Lee was a devoted husband to Hazel Kellogg, his beloved wife of 58 years, and a proud father to three children: Chris Kellogg (and his wife Stephanie), Craig Kellogg, and Cara Pace (and her husband Justin Pace). He was a cherished grandfather to Jared Kellogg (and his wife Brooke) and Wade Kellogg. He is also survived by his sister-in-law, Laurie Kellogg, and his two nieces, Jessika and Jasmine. He was preceded in death by his father, mother and brothers, Edward and Tony.

The family will welcome friends and family on Sunday, June 29, 2025, from 2:00pm-4:00pm at Taylor & Modeen Funeral Home (250 Center Street, Jupiter, FL, 33458). Lee will be laid to rest at South Florida National Cemetery in Lake Worth, Florida, at 12:30pm on Wednesday, July 2, 2025.
