October 7, 1953 - May 20, 2024

Lynn Drake, 70, passed away on Monday, May 20th after courageously battling early-onset Alzheimer's Disease.

Lynn was born October 7, 1953 in Greenville, SC to Franklin and Mary Ann Lasseter. When she was a small child, her family relocated to Jupiter, FL, living first in Suni Sands Trailer Park before moving into their home in the Penn Park section of Jupiter, in 1962. Lynn later graduated from Jupiter High School and spent her lifetime enjoying the Jupiter area.

Many will remember Lynn's infectious smile from behind the bar at Good Friends Pub, Brian's Place and Uncle Mick's. She was a fan of County Music and loved the outdoors. She was a lifelong member of the Daughters of the American Revolution and was a respected Genealogist. Lynn was a fountain of knowledge on Jupiter history and became the Archivist for the Jupiter Inlet Lighthouse and Museum. She, proudly, co-authored the Jupiter Images of America book, with William Carlin White.

Lynn will be deeply missed by those who knew and loved her.

Lynn leaves behind her sister Sherri, several nieces and nephews, longtime friends Karen Gee, Lauri Boreffi, Theresa Adams and her dear friend and former husband, Chris Drake.

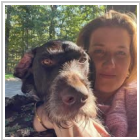
