Martin H. White, 80, of Jupiter, FL passed away peacefully at his home surrounded by his family on June 9, 2012.

Marty, as he was known, was born in Port Jervis , NY in 1932. He moved to Baltimore , MD in 1939 and later graduated from City College High School where he played baseball. He then went on to enlist in the Air Force becoming a Staff Sergeant during the Korean Conflict. In February 1957, after leaving the Air Force, he went back home and met the woman of his dreams, Mary Jane Doyle, of Altoona , PA. Marty and Mary Jane were married in October, 1957. During their 55-year marriage, they lived in Baltimore, MD, Barstow, CA, Austin, TX, Alexandria, VA, Pasadena, MD, and Jupiter, FL, their home for the past 18 years. Marty's career in engineering took off after he graduated from Johns Hopkins University with an engineering degree. He worked for many major corporations such as JPL (on the first moon landing), Bendix, Tracor, EMC, Gould, and Oracle Complex Systems (ORCL) where he retired as the Vice President of Engineering in 1993.

Marty was an avid sports fan of the Baltimore Orioles, Baltimore Colts and, once retired to Jupiter, FL, the Miami Dolphins. He enjoyed boating, fishing, and especially his grandchildren.

Martin is survived by his wife of 55 years, Mary Jane; his children, Stephen, of Hagerstown, MD and his children Matthew and Lauren, Joseph, (Carolyn) of Tequesta, FL and his children Connor and Carly, Jane Czarnecki (Eric) of Naples, FL and her son Austin; his sister, Jean (Ken) Macleod and their two

children, Susan and Debbie of Forest Hill, MD.
