Mary Lou Schaffer, 77, went to be with the Lord on Wednesday September 25, 2024, in Hobe Sound, FL.

Mary Lou was born the third of six children to parents Vincent and Marie Imbriani, in Roslyn Heights, NY. The family spent their early years in Williston Park, NY and in 1952, when Mary Lou was five years old, the family relocated to Miami, FL.

Mary Lou grew up in Miami, attending elementary school at St. James Catholic School and then attending high school at Notre Dame Academy. After graduating from high school, Mary Lou moved to Ft.
