Melvin L Schumer, age 95, passed away peacefully August 20, 2017 surrounded by his 10 children, their spouses and grandchildren.

Mel was born February 27, 1922, the son of Arnold and Lorene Schumer in Perryville Missouri. He served in WWII as a B-24 pilot, earning the Distinguished Flying Cross for his bravery in helping to save his crew after being shot down in Hungary in 1945. He flew a total of 30 missions.

Mel lived most of his life in Youngstown, Ohio, owner of Poland Countryside Furniture which he founded in 1952.

Mel was preceded in death by his beloved Jeanne Lyden Schumer whom he married in 1945.
