Michael Steven Gill, 75, peacefully went to be with his Lord and Savior in the early morning of March 9, 2026 at his home in Jupiter, Florida, with his family present.

He was born on January 21, 1951, in Waco, Texas to Harvey Eugene and Martha Estelle(Peggy) Gill. He graduated from Appalachian State College in Boone, North Carolina. Michael was an avid fisherman and was even pictured once in Florida Sportsman magazine. He was half owner of the very popular Palm Beach Ice Cream with his long time college roommate, Jim Jones. They opened their business originally in Tequesta, Florida in 1985 and expanded to Jupiter in 2001. They were once written up in a 1990 Entrepreneur Magazine for pioneering the use of candy in their products. Over the years they acquired an impressive wholesale business too, in addition to selling at the stores, so that more than 50 restaurants throughout Palm Beach and Martin counties featured Palm Beach icecream. They retired in 2019. The stores remain open at present under new ownership and continues to be a favorite place in Jupiter and Tequesta residents.

His enjoyments, in addition to fishing, were playing golf, traveling, listening to anything by the Beatles, and cheering on his beloved Dallas Cowboys. He was a favorite and dearly loved "Unca/Unka Mike " he was also known as Capt Mike and Pirate Mike. He was a generous soul and had many very loyal

and good friends with whom he enjoyed spending lots of great times. He was a member of the Generation Christian Church.

Survivors include his two sisters; Cyndi(Bob) Sprunk, and Debbie Smalling. His sister-in-law, Chandell Gill. Also 9 nieces and nephews, 16 great nieces and nephews and one great great niece, and his beloved cats, Bonanza and Maybelline. He was preceded in death by his parents, his brother, Gregory Gill, his nephew, Adam Gill, and his brother-in-law, Gary Smalling.
