



Nancy Coprio Rodth

We are saddened to announce the unexpected passing of Nancy Rodth on April 13, 2025, in Jupiter Inlet Colony at the age of 82.

Nancy was born on November 4th, 1942, in Bridgeport, Connecticut to William Coprio and Hazel Phillips Coprio. She graduated from Roger Ludlow High School in Fairfield, Connecticut in 1960 and from secretary school in New York City in 1962. 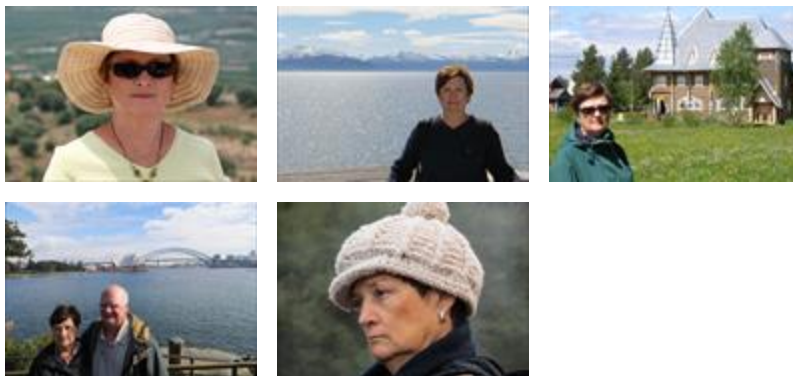

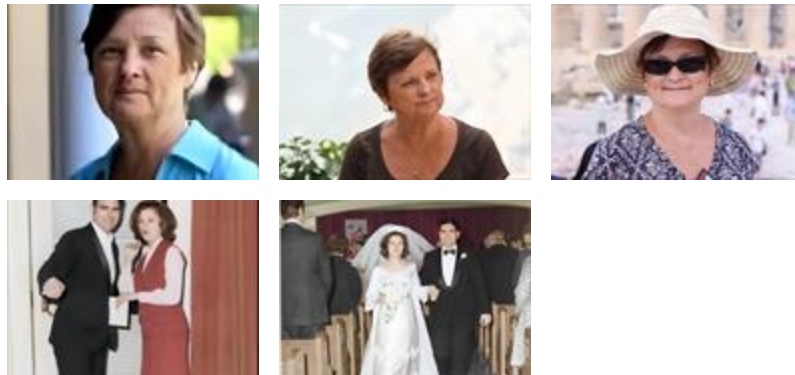
