Pablo Antonio Roman, passed away peacefully on Saturday April 8, 2017, at the age of 97 in Jupiter, Florida. He was born in Lares, Puerto Rico on February 13, 1920. Pablo is survived by his loving wife, Delia Betancourt Roman, of almost 70 years. He was preceded in death by his son, Paul Roman (Kris) and his grandson, Alex Roman.
