Paul Lawrence Robitaille, age 76, passed away peacefully at his home in Jupiter, FL on February 6, 2023. He is survived by Norma Robitaille, his wife of 46 years, his four daughters Collette Raymond (Carl), Renee Brodbeck (Benjamin), Jacqui Pettingil (Ed), Mary Beth Martinsen (Peter) and his five grandchildren, Rollin Paul Brodbeck, Maxwell Lewis Brodbeck, Carissa Pettingil, Sophia Pettingil, and Lawrence Pettingil.

He was born in Scotia, New York where he grew up in a large family, with 3 sisters and a brother. In 1969 he moved to West Palm Beach, FL where he met Norma. After they married in 1976, they built a home in Jupiter, FL and raised their family. Paul worked at Florida Power & Light for 38 years and retired in 2007 as an IBEW Transmission Splicer. He was always willing to do barge work for submarine outages. His work friends knew him as “Robi”.

Paul and Norma spent summers in Lake George, NY enjoying the cool weather, kayaking and reminiscing with high school friends. Paul had a passion for plants, gardening and maintaining his yard in Jupiter. He kept his mind and body busy with weekly golf tee times, swimming in his lap pool, reading and attending yoga and meditation classes. Paul and Norma were avid football fans cheering on the Miami Dolphins and Florida Gators. Paul

never turned down an opportunity to have a sleepover and campfire with his grandsons, who called him "Papa".

On Saturday, February 11th, the family will receive visitors, from 10AM-11AM and a Memorial Service will be held at 11AM, at Taylor & Modeen Funeral Home, 250 Center St. Jupiter, Fl. A Celebration of Life will follow, at the home of Paul and Norma, in Jupiter.
