Richard Foppiano, 90, of Jupiter, Florida passed away at his home on December 21, 2021 after a brave battle with brain cancer.

Born in Everett, MA, he was a resident of Jupiter for 34 years, coming from Miami, Florida. Mr. Foppiano was a member of St. Jude's Catholic Church. Richard proudly served his country as a Sergeant in the Army and fought in the Korean War. He was awarded two Bronze Service Stars, United Nations Service Medal and National Defense Service Medal. Richard was a firefighter for Metro Dade County for 25 years.
