



Robert "Bob" H. Bormann

May 7, 1926 - November 23, 2022

Robert H. Bormann (Bob) was born May 7, 1926, to Florence and Herman Bormann in Yonkers, New York. He died peacefully at home in Tequesta, FL. on November 23, 2022, surrounded by loved ones. Bob was a devoted and loving husband, father, grandfather and friend who touched many lives in Florida, Minnesota and Illinois. He was preceded in death by Terrie, wife of 62 years, grandson Christopher, son-in-law Larry McIntyre and stepson Tom Yeager. He was a devout Catholic and faithful church member throughout his life, serving as a Lector and Eucharistic Minister, volunteered at St Annes Place distributing food to the homeless, was a Pastoral Minister at the local hospital, sang said prayers and distributed communion at Mangrove Bay, volunteer assisting the Department of Corrections (Prison Ministry and was a member of the Knights of Columbus as well as several other ministries. Churches include St. Jude, Jupiter, FL; St. Christopher's, Nisswa, MN; and St. Thomas Aquinas, Freeport, IL.

He is survived by his wife Judy Englert-Bormann, children Paul (Yvonne), Peter (Lynn), Robert, and Kathleen McIntyre; stepchildren Dr. Christopher Englert (Kathleen), Stephany Eddowes (Chris), Candy Yeager; grandchildren Justin, Kelly, Michael, Lisa, Madelyn, Mason; step grandchildren Lauren, James, Carolyn, Erica, Leisa, Jason, Tori.

Bob graduated from Cardinal Hayes High School in New York City in 1944. In

his younger years, he was a soda pop vendor in Yankee Stadium and an usher at Radio City Music Hall.

Bob entered the New York State Maritime Academy and served as a midshipman, graduating as a Lieutenant in the U.S. Navy and a Third Mate in the Merchant Marine in October 1946. From 1946 to 1949, he sailed ships all over the world. He attended Manhattan College, graduating in 1951 with a degree in Civil Engineering, followed by earning a Master's Degree in Mechanical Engineering from Columbia University. During the Korean War, he served the U.S. Navy as an Inspection Officer for the Supervisor of Shipbuilding, Chicago, IL. He recently took part in an Honor Flight trip which celebrates America's veterans by inviting them to share in a day of honor at our nation's memorials in Washington, D.C.

In 1951, Bob joined Honeywell, Inc. as a Sales Engineer in New York City. He was promoted to Sales Manager for upstate New York and moved to Syracuse. In 1968, he was transferred to Minneapolis, MN, as a Marketing Manager, and in 1977, he was promoted to Vice President of Marketing with Microswitch (Div. of Honeywell) in Freeport, IL.

Upon retirement in 1987, he and wife Terrie moved to Lake Shore, MN on Gull Lake, where they spent summers. They declared residency in Tequesta, FL and enjoyed warmer winters there.

The funeral Mass will be held at St. Jude Catholic Church in Jupiter, FL on December 3 at 1:00 PM.
