Robert J. Brown entered into eternal life on March 26, 2017 following a brief illness. Mr. Brown was a retired engineer for Pratt & Whitney Aircraft in West Palm Beach having worked there for 35 years.

He was a member of the First Presbyterian Church of Sebastian, Fl. where he served as an Elder for 6 years and was chairman of the Building and Grounds Committee and co chairman of the Thrift Shop. Mr. Brown was a long time member of the Masonic Lodge of Jupiter having served as Master of the Lodge in 2004. He was currently a dual member of Sebastian Lodge #204. He was a member of Azan Shrine in Melbourne, Fl. and was serving as Secretary/Treasurer of the Sebastian Shrine Club at the time of his death. He was a member of the Order of the Eastern Star in both Jupiter and Sebastian and served as Worthy Patron many times in both chapters. He was a Past Royal Patron of Ida E. Banks Court #51, Order of the Amaranth and Past Watchman of Shepherds of Judea Shrine #14, Order of the White Shrine of Jerusalem.
