Robert James Cato (Bob), 73, of Okeechobee and formerly of Jupiter, FL, passed away peacefully August 25, 2015, surrounded by his loving family. Bob was born in Vero Beach FL to Avon Charles Cato and Ida Mae Hall Cato. His family moved to Jupiter FL in 1947 when his father took the job of bridgetender at the A1A bridge from Jupiter over to Jupiter Island, now called Cato's Bridge. He attended Jupiter schools for 12 years, worked for Wilbur Plumbing and Dixie Plumbing, and resided in Jupiter until 1986 when he moved to Clyde, North Carolina to establish his own business, Cato Plumbing. He retired in 2013 and returned to Florida, settling in Okeechobee to be close to family, play golf but mostly so he could fulfill his passion to fish "to his heart's content."
