



Robert Martin Kogler

November 10, 1926 - May 21, 2016

Born November 10, 1926, Bob was 89 years old when he passed away on May 21, 2016. He was the son of Charles and Dorothy Kogler of Syracuse, New York. Preceding him in death was his first wife Marilyn, the mother of his two children, and two brother's Richard "Dick" of Baton Rouge, LA and Charles "Chuck." Before moving to Jupiter, Florida in 2009, Bob spent most of his adult life in Syracuse, NY. He was a printer employed by the Syracuse newspaper and worked in the composing room. He retired after 49 years in 1992. In his pastime, he enjoyed woodworking and built several elaborate pieces of furniture for his home. He belonged to several fraternal organizations and held prestigious positions in all of them, e.g. Master of Onondaga Lodge #802 in 1980, Potentate of Tigris Shrine in Syracuse in 1993, President of the New York/Ontario Shrine Association in 1996. He was also a member in good standing in the Scottish Rite and the America Legion Post 1468. He was a 32° mason. A devoted Christian, Bob retained the position of head usher at St. Paul's United Methodist Church on Onondaga Hill, Syracuse, NY for 23 years and was there every Sunday to see that all went smoothly. He met his second wife, Dr. Cynthia Crowley Kogler PhD, on a Panama Canal cruise in 1993, and they married August 27, 1994. They travelled together often and lived happily together until his death. He is survived by his wife, Cynthia; his two children, Mark (Elaine), a civil engineer living in Skaneateles, and daughter Kristen Kogler, a suny-potsdam graduate living in Seattle, Washington; one grandchild Emily Moore, Washington; a

sister, the Reverend Dorothy Auer of Exton, Pennsylvania and several nieces and nephews. An honest, sincere man, dedicated to his causes, and a loving husband, he will be dearly missed by all who knew him well. God bless him.
