Robert John Kotecki, 70, was called to his heavenly home on January 2, 2016. Bob was diagnosed with pancreatic & liver cancer on November 23, 2015. Born in Hammond, IN, he grew up in Calumet City, IL attending St. Anthony's School & TF North High School, where he played basketball & elected Senior Class president. After graduating from Northern Illinois University with a math major, he taught math at his alma mater for two years before teaching in Bermuda, Germany & Italy for the DOD. He married Sharon in 1973 & received his MA in Education in 1975. Returning stateside, he pursued a career with State Farm Insurance in Jupiter, FL from 1976-2008. Active in the community, he presided as president of the Chamber of Commerce, participated the Exchange Club & as board member of a local bank, The King's Academy, & Grace Immanuel Bible Church Elder board. His life was consumed with family & his beloved church family, but foremost is his love for the Lord Jesus Christ with Whom he now lives for eternity.
